

## Are you ready for Fair?!

There is always the common question of: Did you complete all the steps to be eligible to exhibit at fair? Please see the below check-lists to see if you have completed all the steps for your projects!

- Family Consumer/General Natural/County Projects
  - Dog ID's: Were Due May 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Interview Judging sign-up by July 6<sup>th</sup>. Interview judging day is Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. To sign up visit: <https://scheduler.co.weld.co.us/index.php?r=site/login>
    - **Dog and Crops/Vegetable members *must* sign up for an interview for the corresponding project record book. Failure to sign-up for a record book interview will result in participation only in those two divisions.**
  - Fair Entries: either paper entries from Fair Book or online at: [www.weldcountyfair.com](http://www.weldcountyfair.com). Entries close July 6<sup>th</sup>!!
  - Do you have the proper Record Book? Visit [http://colorado4h.org/project\\_resources/erecords/index.php](http://colorado4h.org/project_resources/erecords/index.php) to find the appropriate e-record. For Crops, Pocket Pets and Restoration projects, please use the Self Determined e-record.
  - Shooting Sports: You will need to download your record book from the link above. The manual you received from your leader is not your record book, just a manual for information.
  - Do you know your project requirements? Refer to your project section in the Fairbook for those details! Some projects require only exhibit item and record book, some require a completed manual in addition to those

  - Market Animal ID Days
    - Cattle: February
    - Sheep, Goats and Pigs: May
    - Rabbits: Doe ID's were due May 1<sup>st</sup>; Meat Pen tag-in June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 1 – 3 pm at Southeast Weld County Fairgrounds, Keenesburg
  - Horse Project
    - Horse ID's were due May 1<sup>st</sup>
    - Level testing completed by July 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Are you up-to-date on your Meat Quality Assurance (MQA) and Pork Quality Assurance (PQA)?
