

Are you ready for Fair?!

There is always the common question of: Did you complete all the steps to be eligible to exhibit at fair? Please see the below check-lists to see if you have completed all the steps for your projects!

- Family Consumer/General Natural/County Projects
 - Dog ID's are due in 4-H Online by May 1st. You must update previously used dogs, they do not automatically carry over
 - Interview Judging sign-up by July 6th. Interview judging day is Monday, July 23rd.
 - **Dog and Crops/Vegetable members *must* sign up for an interview for the corresponding project record book. Failure to sign-up for a record book interview will result in participation only in those two divisions.**
 - Fair Entries: either paper entries from Fair Book or online at: www.weldcountyfair.com. Entries close July 6th!!
 - Do you have the proper Record Book? Visit http://colorado4h.org/project_resources/erecords/index.php to find the appropriate e-record. For Crops, Pocket Pets and Restoration projects, please use the Self Determined e-record.
 - Shooting Sports: You will need to download your record book from the link above. The manual you received from your leader is not your record book, just a manual for information.
 - Do you know your project requirements? Refer to your project section in the Fairbook for those details! Some projects require only exhibit item and record book, some require a completed manual in addition to those

 - Market Animal ID Days
 - Cattle: February
 - Sheep and Goats: Live ID Days at the following-locations
 - Island Grove Park, Greeley: Tuesday, May 1, 4-6 pm
 - Briggsdale School FFA Shop: Wednesday, May 2, 4-6 pm
 - Southeast Weld County Fairgrounds (Keenesburg): Thursday, May 3, 4-6 pm
 - Pigs: Must pick up paper work from office and paperwork due back to the Extension Office by 5 pm May 3rd **or** by 6 pm at the Southeast Weld Fairgrounds in Keenesburg.
 - Rabbits: Doe ID's Due to the Extension Office by May 1st
 - Rabbit Meat Pen tag-in June 30th, 2018 1 – 3 pm at Southeast Weld County Fairgrounds, Keenesburg
 - Horse Project
 - Horse ID's due in 4-H Online by May 1st
 - Level testing completed by July 1st

- Animal Care and Housing Forms – Due May 1st
- Breeding Animal Ownership Deadline – May 1st
