

BEEF EXCELLENCE COMMITTEE/EARL KINDSFATER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

APPLICANTS

To be eligible for a scholarship an applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Be presently enrolled and active in a Weld County 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.
2. Must have completed a least four years of Market or Breeding Beef project work.
3. Must have exhibited a Market Beef or Breeding Beef animal at the Weld County Junior Fair or Colorado State Fair at least one time during the last four years; and
4. Be a graduating senior in a Weld County High School and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of not less than 3.0.

APPLICATION

4-H Club and FFA members may obtain application forms from the Weld County Extension Office or by calling the Beef Excellence Committee, Inc. at 970-590-3560.

An official transcript from the applicant's high school, certification of student rank in graduating class, and an ACT or SAT score must accompany the application form.

WINNER SELECTION

The selection committee will choose one or more recipients based on scholastic achievement, beef project and 4-H and/or FFA accomplishments, leadership and community involvement. Determination of the Selection Committee is final.

If any recipient receives a full-ride (Boettcher or similar) scholarship, this scholarship would then be forfeited and awarded to another qualified applicant.

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP

To receive payment, the student must attend an accredited four year college or university or a two year institution whose credits are transferable to a four year institution. The student must attend the fall term immediately following graduation from high school. The applicant must be enrolled in a program leading to a bachelor's degree.

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PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. Immediately after completion of registration in the approved college or university, the recipient should notify the Beef Excellence Committee, Inc.
2. A proof of registration form must be mailed to the Beef Excellence Committee, P.O. Box 27, Roggen, CO 80652-0027.
3. Payment of \$500.00 will then be paid to the recipient.
