

4-H Shooting Sports Senior Project

Description (continued):

Year 2: Prepare a 9 to 11 minute, high quality video presenting the Year 1 research paper.

- The video should contain the following:
 - Narrative introducing the 4-H member and explaining the project.
 - Supporting pictures, drawings, video, animations, tables, graphs, or calculations which illustrate the concepts being presented.
 - Music or graphics enhancing the appeal of the presentation.
- Eligibility: Only Year 1 projects receiving a Red or Blue Fair award are eligible for Year 2 of the project.

Year 1 projects may be suspended for no more than 1 year before progressing to the Year 2 portion of the project.

- Fair Display (Phase One) to include:
 - Original research paper from Year 1 project without change.
 - An addendum may be added to explain any minor revisions to research content included in the video. The basic concept cannot be changed.
 - Completed 4-H record Book.
 - The 9 to 11 minute video in MP4 format shall be submitted on a flash drive.

The Fair project will be judged by standard procedures.

- STEM Competition (Phase Two):
 - All Blue and Red award winners regardless of Fair placing are eligible to compete in Phase 2.
 - The video and supporting research paper will be judged for merit and presentation according to an established rubric.
 - Cash awards will be provided to the top finisher(s) provided they satisfy minimum requirements established by the rubric.

All materials electronic or printed that are submitted as part of this project will become property of CSU extension service to be used as desired within the 4-H program.
